7. New Business:

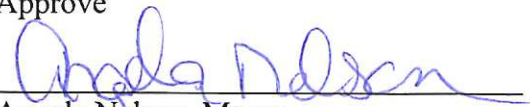
- a) Discussion and/or Action: Texas Pumps Contract for Clearwell Ground Storage tank.
