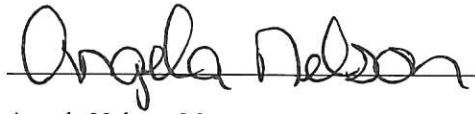

- A motion was made by Joe Sterner to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Becky Decker. The motion carried unanimously.

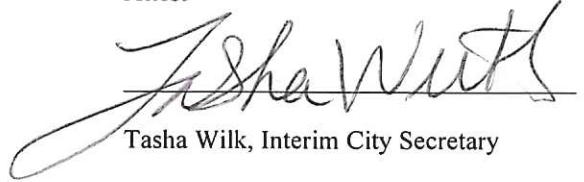
